

OVERVIEW

This centre is based at one of America's most prestigious Ivy League universities. Founded in 1701, Yale University's 260-acre campus offers a peaceful and well equipped environment for study. 

TUITION

Students will take part in 17.5 hours of English language lessons per week. Lessons are topic based and designed to be fun, energetic and informative. They enable students to use their English in real world situations and increase their confidence.

EXCURSIONS

Full and half day excursions allow students to really get to know New Haven and the USA. We use popular destinations as a classroom where students will find historic and cultural information through guided walking tours and visits to museums and other places of interest.



CERTIFICATE

Each student will have their English level tested upon arrival and will be placed in a class accordingly. Students will receive a portfolio to store their work in as well as a certificate to take home with them as a record of their course with us.
