## **PUBLIC TRANSPORT INFORMATION:**

#### Onsite Nurse

Each of our residential centres in summer 2022 will have a nurse available onsite during the school day to assist students who are feeling unwell.

#### Temperature Checks

Regular temperature checks of students and staff will be taken using non-contact infra-red thermometers. These are quick and simple and can be carried out at a distance.

### Doctors on Call

We will also have GMC registered doctors in the UK on call (at a supplementary cost) to provide telephone/ video consultations should the need arise.

They will be able to provide a thorough diagnosis and prescribe any medication required.

#### Medical Room

If a student does begin to feel unwell during the school day a medical room will be available for them to isolate, relax and recuperate in a restful environment.

## WHAT'S INCLUDED:



#### **TUITION**

Students will take part in 15 hours of English language lessons per week. Lessons are topic based and designed to be fun, energetic and informative. They enable students to use their English in real world situations and increase their confidence.



#### **ACTIVITIES**

We offer a variety of activities including sports, arts and crafts and workshops. Our activities provide opportunities for students to use the English they have learnt in the classroom with their friends.



#### **EXCURSIONS**

Full and half day excursions, as well as local visits allow students to really get to know the UK. Students can explore the delightful city of Chichester on sightseeing tours. Destinations such as London become a classroom, where students will find historic and cultural information through guided walking



#### CERTIFICATE

Each student will have their English level tested upon arrival and will be placed in a class accordingly. Students will receive a portfolio to store their work in as well as a certificate to take home with them as a record of their course with us.
