

Doctors on Call

Each of our residential centres in summer 2021 will have a nurse available onsite during the school day to assist students who are feeling unwell.

Regular temperature checks of students and staff will be taken using non-contact infra-red thermometers. These are quick and simple and can be carried out at a

We will also have GMC registered doctors in the UK on call (at a supplementary cost) to provide telephone/ video consultations should the need arise. They will be able to provide a thorough diagnosis and prescribe any medication

If a student does begin to feel unwell

during the school day a medical room will

be available for them to isolate, relax and recuperate in a restful environment.

### EXCURSIONS

Full and half day excursions, as well as local visits allow students to really get to know the UK. Students can explore the UK on sightseeing tours. Destinations such as London become a classroom, where students will find historic and cultural information through guided walking tours.



### CERTIFICATE

Each student will have their English level tested upon arrival and will be placed in a class accordingly. Students will receive a portfolio to store their work in as well as a certificate to take home with them as a record of their course with us.
