HAND SANITISER



Our English Language courses in the UK are accredited by The British Council. We are also founder members of Young Learners English UK, a group who are dedicated to ensuring excellence in all aspects of junior courses, especially student welfare.

SECURITY

Our schools have always been a safe haven for students and we have highly developed contingency plans in place in the unlikely event of an emergency. Our staff are fully trained in these procedures so students can always feel they are in safe hands whilst in the care of Stafford House.

Our Intensive course in Canterbury and The London Academic Explorer courses are the perfect choice for those keen to expand their knowledge and practise their skills. The London and Edinburgh explorer programmes provide an opportunity to get to know two of the UK's most popular cities through walking tours, visits and lessons.



CLASSIC COURSE

EXPLORER COURSE

AGE: 8-18* years for groups, 12-17 years for individuals (varies by centre)

DURATION: 1-4 weeks

ENGLISH LESSONS: 15 hours per week

LOCATION: Most of our centres

This course includes a full programme of English tuition, supervised excursions, sports and on-site activities such as arts and crafts, drama and evening activities.

- Maximum class size of 16 students
- 1 full-day plus 1 or 2 half-day excursions per week
- Themed lessons prepare students for excursions
- Full board accommodation, usually residential (homestay option in Brighton, Canterbury and London Bloomsbury)

- AGE: 10-18* years (Edinburgh), 12-18* years (London) for groups
- **DURATION:** 1-4 weeks
- ENGLISH LESSONS: 15 hours per week

LOCATION: London Bloomsbury or Edinburgh

An exciting way to combine exploring London or Edinburgh with an integrated programme of English Language lessons.

- AGE: 14-17 years for groups and individuals **DURATION:** 1-6 weeks
- ENGLISH LESSONS: 23 hours per week

INTENSIVE ENGLISH

LOCATION: Canterbury

This course provides more classroom time for students to focus on their English Language knowledge and skills, as well as participating in supervised activities and excursions.

- Maximum class size of 16 students
- Evening social activities included
- 1 afternoon activity per week
- 1 full-day excursion per week



LONDON ACADEMIC **EXPLORER**

AGE: 14-17 years for small groups and individuals

- **DURATION:** 2 weeks
- **ENGLISH LESSONS:** 20 hours per week
- LOCATION: London
- MINIMUM LEVEL: Pre-Intermediate

The Academic Explorer Programme is designed to have a dramatic effect on students' performance in English. Focusing on intercultural communicative success in English- with outcomes focused on the successful communication of group work objectives through the acquisition of presentation skills. Includes skills such as academic note-taking and spoken performance.

- Maximum class size of 15 students
- Excursions to Cambridge (including University visit) and Thorpe Park

• 4 half day tours per week around London tied in to learning objectives and 4 premium activities per week (all entrance fees included)

• Full board residential accommodation





*18 year old students only accepted as part of a group where all students are returning to secondary education in September 2021. 18 year olds must follow all school rules as minors.

- AGE: 14-17 years (groups and individuals) **DURATION: 3-4 weeks**
- ENGLISH LESSONS: 23 hours per week **LOCATION:** Canterbury MINIMUM LEVEL: Upper-Intermediate **EXAM:** Optional

This is a course specially designed for students who have been studying towards the Cambridge English First Examination. Students will receive Cambridge English B2 First practice materials, regular assessments and self-study guidance. The exam can be taken during the final week of the course.

- Maximum class size of 16 students
- Evening social activities included
 - One afternoon activity per week
 - exam as part of the course (extra cost)

CAMBRIDGE ENGLISH (B2 FIRST PREPARATION COURSE)

Option to take Cambridge English First

TRINITY EXAMINATIONS COURSE

AGE: 8-18* years (varies by centre) DURATION: 2-4 weeks **ENGLISH LESSONS:** 15 hours per week plus 2 exam preparation sessions

LOCATION: All UK centres (groups only)

The Trinity GESE (Graded Examinations in Spoken English) examinations are an internationally recognised qualification and are ideal as a motivational end-focus for students. The supplement includes 2 lessons to help them understand what to expect during the exam and to help them with strategies to pass the exam. The exam will be taken during the final week of the course.

- Maximum class size of 16 students
- Lessons may replace some or part of the student's daily activities
- All learning materials will be provided and a formal Trinity College certificate will be issued to successful candidates

CLASSIC PLUS COURSES

ADVENTURE ACTIVITIES

AGE: 8-17 years (groups), 12-17 (individuals) DURATION: 1-4 weeks LOCATION: Oakham **COACHING:** 9 hours per week **ENGLISH LEVEL:** Pre-Intermediate to Advanced ABILITY LEVEL: Beginner to Advanced

Students on this course will participate in an exciting range of activities based mainly in and around Rutland Water, a reservoir and nature reserve near to the school. Activities may include various types of watersports, horse riding, climbing, building rafts and emergency shelters, orienteering, and a guided cycle ride around Rutland Water.

DRAMA

AGE: 8-17 years (groups), 12-17 (individuals) DURATION: 1-2 weeks LOCATION: Malvern, Woodcote **COACHING:** 9 hours per week **ENGLISH LEVEL:** Elementary to Advanced **ABILITY LEVEL:** Beginner to Advanced

On this course, you will develop your knowledge and techniques in drama and performing arts, work on your physical and vocal skills, and develop your scene writing skills. Students will work together as a team towards a small performance at the end of the week and/or fortnight.

SAILING

AGE: 12-16 years (groups only) DURATION: 2 weeks (11-25 July) LOCATION: Dover College **COACHING:** 9 hours per week **ENGLISH LEVEL:** Elementary to Advanced ABILITY LEVEL: Beginner (all students must be able to swim confidently in the sea)

This course is designed to enable students to build confidence in the water while having fun. The group sessions will take place with a Royal Yachting Association Instructor in Dover Harbour and will focus on a range of sailing techniques. Students will gain experience of steering and handling a boat as well as launching and recovery, and will leave with an official Royal Yachting Association Certificate.

ART

AGE: 8-17 years (groups) DURATION: 1-2 weeks LOCATION: Malvern **COACHING:** 9 hours per week **ENGLISH LEVEL:** Elementary to Advanced **ABILITY LEVEL:** Beginner to Advanced

This course aims to provide students with a broad working knowledge of a number of artistic disciplines, which may include painting, drawing, sculpture, photography, mixed media and 3D work. Students will learn to use a working sketchbook, create a portfolio, and present their art to other students in a gallery context.

VIDEO GAME CODING

AGE: 8-17 years (groups), 12-17 (individuals) **DURATION:** 1-2 weeks LOCATION: Oakham **COACHING:** 9 hours per week ENGLISH LEVEL: Pre-Intermediate to Advanced ABILITY LEVEL: Elementary to Advanced

Students will discover the basics of programming and coding in a fun and interesting way, by learning to design their own video game. Creativity and problem solving skills are developed in an environment where they can pursue and implement their own game ideas, taking inspiration from a variety of game genres. The course concludes with an awards ceremony to recognize their efforts and they will be able to take their projects home with them on a handy USB drive.

TENNIS

AGE: 8-17 years (groups), 12-17 (individuals) DURATION: 1-4 weeks LOCATION: Woodcote **COACHING:** 9 hours per week **ENGLISH LEVEL:** Elementary to Advanced **ABILITY LEVEL:** Beginner to Advanced

Students will enjoy 9 hours per week of professional tennis coaching. The sessions will include technical development for all shots used in the game including groundstrokes, serve, return of serve and net play, together with an emphasis on the tactics and strategies required in match play, including court positioning for both singles and doubles matches.

BASKETBALL

AGE: 12-17 years (groups), 14-17 (individuals) **DURATION:** 1–4 weeks **LOCATION:** Canterbury **COACHING:** 9 hours per week **ENGLISH LEVEL:** Elementary to Advanced **ABILITY LEVEL:** Beginner to Advanced

We will provide students with 9 hours per week of basketball coaching by accredited coaches. The training will focus on all the skills and techniques used in the game, including dribbling, shooting, passing, court awareness and teamwork. Students are encouraged to practise and demonstrate what they have learnt, through competitive exercises, culminating in an exciting tournament each week.

HORSE RIDING

AGE: 8-17 years (groups), 12-17 (individuals) DURATION: 1-4 weeks LOCATION: Oakham **COACHING:** 9 hours per week

ENGLISH LEVEL: Pre-Intermediate to Advanced **ABILITY LEVEL:** Elementary to Advanced

Students will be taught how to groom horses, how to keep a horse and its stable clean, and how to use and handle riding equipment, as well as enjoying indoor and outdoor riding sessions with qualified instructors within the safe environment of the riding centre.



WHAT'S ON THE MENU?
