

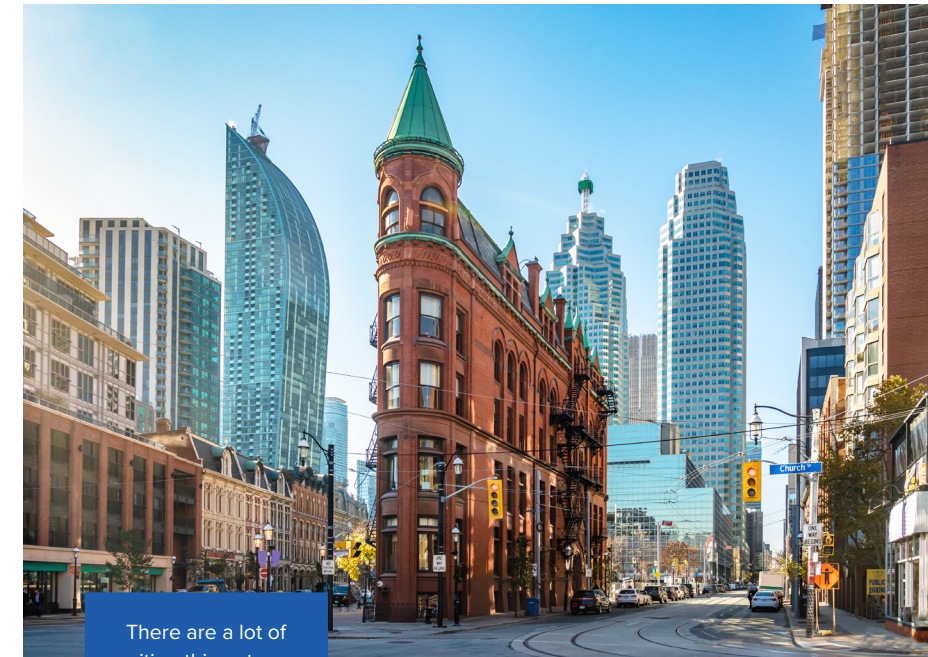

OVERVIEW

In 2019, The Economist ranked Toronto as the 6th safest city in the world and the safest city in North America. It is the home of the tallest structure in North America and third tallest in the world (The CN Tower), the longest street in the world (Yonge Street), and the NBA champions (The Raptors)! You can choose to spend the day at one of Toronto's islands, at one of the many parks and nature trails, at the beach, or at one of the different ethnic pockets around the city such as China Town, Little Italy, Portugal Village, and Greek Town just to name a few.

THE SCHOOL

Stafford House's Junior programme is specifically designed with juniors in mind. Class time is focused on language acquisition through intriguing lessons and engaging language production exercises. The school is situated in a friendly neighbourhood, right in the North York Centre, so students have access to the North York Central Library and a direct indoor connection to the subway station. 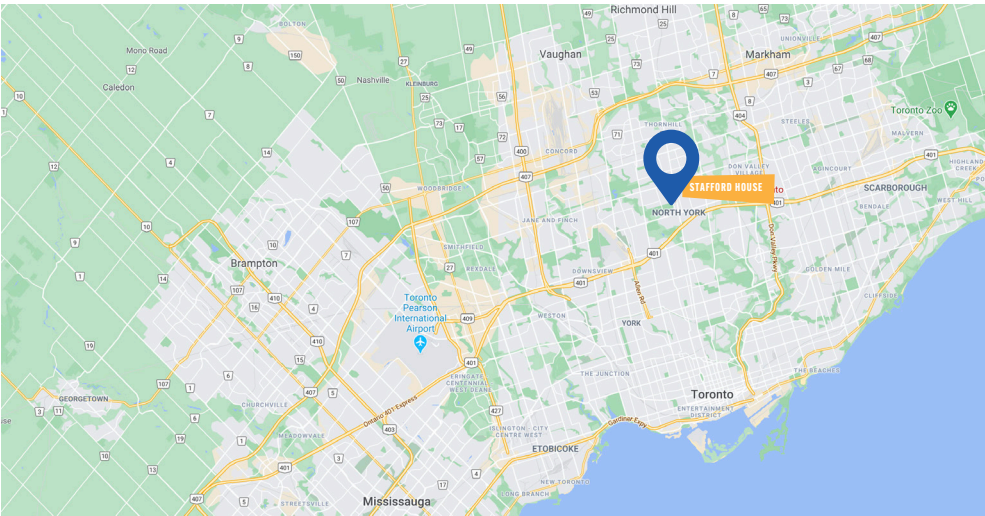

WHAT'S INCLUDED:




TUITION
Students will take part in 15 hours of English language lessons per week. Lessons are topic based and designed to be fun, energetic and informative. They enable students to use their English in real world situations and increase their confidence.



ACTIVITIES
We offer a variety of activities including quizzes, arts and crafts and team games. Our activities provide opportunities for students to use the English they have learnt and make international friends.



EXCURSIONS
Full and half day excursions allow students to really get to know Toronto and the surrounding area. Locations such Niagara Falls become a classroom, where students will find historic and cultural information through guided walking tours and visits to museums and other places of interest.



CERTIFICATE
Each student will have their English level tested upon arrival and will be placed in a class accordingly. Students will receive a portfolio to store their work in as well as a certificate to take home with them as a record of their course with us.



Medical Facilities

Temperature Checks
