## OVERVIEW

Uxbridge is a suburban town in west London. The town centre is easily accessed from Brunel University either by walking, or a short bus ride. In the town our students can enjoy a coffee in Starbucks or a spot of shopping - there are many major high street stores, including an expansive Primark. Uxbridge has an underground train station with links directly into central London (approx. 1 hour). Its proximity to London means students can enjoy visits into London on half-day coach excursions.

## THE UNIVERSITY

Brunel University occupies a modern and spacious campus, 15 minutes' walk from the lively town of Uxbridge, West London. The campus has some of the finest sports facilities in the country – which often host world-class athletes, including the British, US and Jamaican athletics teams. All classrooms, leisure facilities and accommodation are of a very high standard. As well as a range of on-campus amenities, students benefit from their proximity to Central London, with all the major attractions being easily accessible.

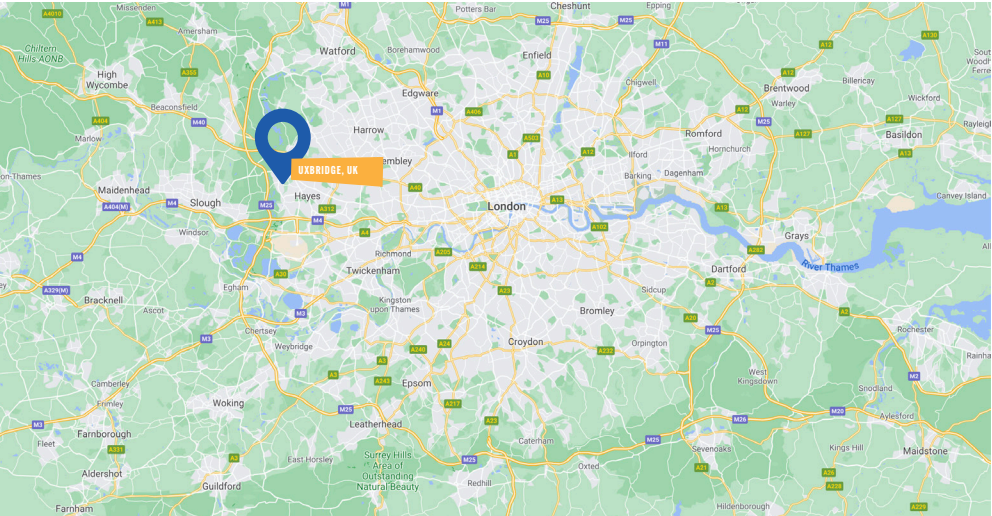

WHAT'S INCLUDED:




**TUITION**  
Students will take part in 15 hours of English language lessons per week. Lessons are topic based and designed to be fun, energetic and informative. They enable students to use their English in real world situations and increase their confidence.



**ACTIVITIES**  
We offer a variety of onsite activities including sports, arts and crafts and team games. Our activities provide opportunities for students to use the English they have learnt and make international friends.



**EXCURSIONS**  
Full and half day excursions allow students to really get to know the UK. We use popular destinations as a classroom where students will find historic and cultural information through guided walking tours and visits to museums and other places of interest.



**CERTIFICATE**  
Each student will have their English level tested upon arrival and will be placed in a class accordingly. Students will receive a portfolio to store their work in as well as a certificate to take home with them as a record of their course with us.



**Onsite Nurses**  
Each of our residential centres in summer 2021 will have a nurse available onsite during the school day to assist students who are feeling unwell.

**Doctors on Call**  
We will also have GMC registered doctors in the UK on call (at a supplementary cost) to provide telephone/ video consultations should the need arise. They will be able to provide a thorough diagnosis and prescribe any medication required.

**Temperature Checks**  
Regular temperature checks of students and staff will be taken using non-contact infra-red thermometers. These are quick and simple and can be carried out at a distance.

**Medical Room**  
If a student does begin to feel unwell during the school day a medical room will be available for them to isolate, relax and recuperate in a restful environment
