OVERVIEW

Brighton is one of the UK's most diverse and liberal cities. A truly unique seaside city located on the sunny South East coast of England. It's a very warm and welcoming place for international visitors. Each year it attracts up to 11 million tourists. It's an equally popular place to live, especially for young people, and is often referred to as the "happiest place to live in the UK". THE SCHOOL

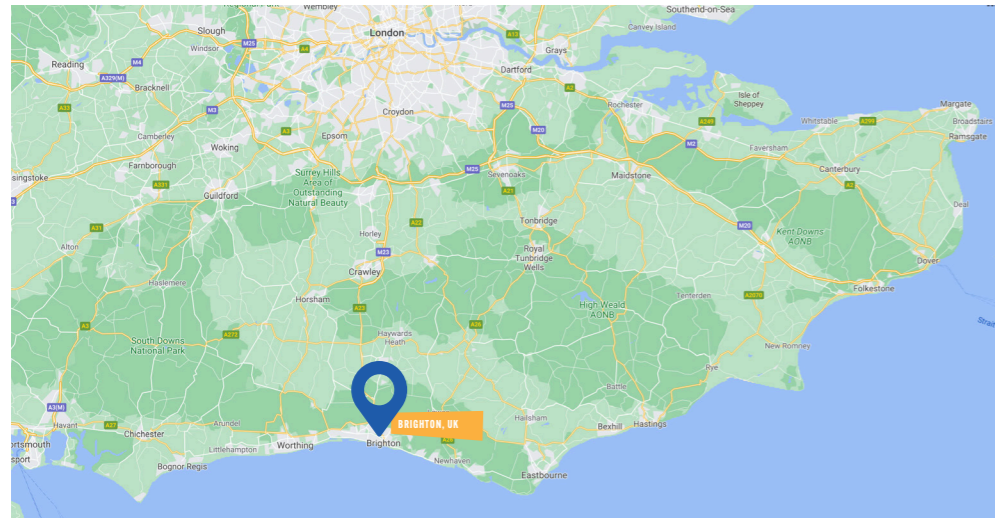

WHAT'S INCLUDED:



TUITION

Students will take part in 15 hours of English language lessons per week. Lessons are topic based and designed to be fun, energetic and informative. They enable students to use their English in real world situations and increase their confidence.



ACTIVITIES

We offer a variety of activities including sports, arts and crafts and workshops. Our activities provide opportunities for students to use the English they have learnt in the classroom with their friends.



EXCURSIONS

Full and half day excursions, as well as local visits allow students to really get to know the UK. Students can explore the buzzing city of Brighton on sightseeing tours. Destinations such as London become a classroom, where students will find historic and cultural information through guided walking tours.



CERTIFICATE

Each student will have their English level tested upon arrival and will be placed in a class accordingly. Students will receive a portfolio to store their work in as well as a certificate to take home with them as a record of their course with us.

Medical Facilities

The school is situated centrally and has medical facilities located nearby. Stafford House staff will be able to assist students that require an appointment. * at cost

Temperature Checks

Regular temperature checks of students and staff will be taken using non-contact infra-red thermometers. These are quick and simple and can be carried out at a distance.

Doctors on Call

We will also have GMC registered doctors in the UK on call (at a supplementary cost) to provide telephone/ video consultations should the need arise. They will be able to provide a thorough diagnosis and prescribe any medication required.

Medical Room

If a student does begin to feel unwell during the school day a medical room will be available for them to isolate, relax and recuperate in a restful environment.
